The Saltram Mamre Brook range is a tribute to the Barossa and Eden Valleys. Mamre Brook is the name of the original home at the Saltram Estate at Angaston in the Barossa Valley. The home was built in 1844 and is the traditional home of Saltram's chief winemaker.

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#### Vineyard Region

South Eastern Australia

#### Vintage Conditions

100% Chardonnay was sourced from the Barossa region. Above average winter and spring rains replenished water reserves and prepared the region for the heat to come. Conditions throughout flowering and fruit set were ideal, ensuring solid yields. Vintage was very hot and around two weeks early. Chardonnay showed outstanding varietal characteristics.
